

ADELINA'S SUCCESS IS YOUR SUCCESS!

I am thrilled to report that Adelina has successfully exited the Identity Mission Family Preservation Program! If you have been following her story with us, you truly know that it has been one of courage and hard work, with several miracles of provision mixed in! A quick recap for those of you that perhaps missed part of this single mom's determination to not only provide for her daughter but also to help other children in her poor community is the following:

Stage 1: Identity Mission paid Adelina to care for 4 children; providing immediate work for her and emergency care for the 4 children that were at risk of entering the orphanage system.

Stage 2: Adelina expressed the desire to assist more children in her community that were also being left alone in vulnerable situations while their parents went to work. She showed great potential for learning how to operate a business of her own and to care well for children.

Stage 3: Carlos, our Family Preservation Director, worked with Adelina to create a business plan to run her own daycare in her slum community.

Stage 4: Adelina attended several parenting courses and other training sessions offered by Identity Mission. She learned the basics of early childhood education from a partner expert.

Stage 5: THE DAYCARE OPENED! And through the assistance of a local church and other resources, Adelina received a building and materials for her daycare to operate well.

And now we've reached the final stage, where Adelina has several children attending the daycare and she is bringing in enough income to purchase all her own materials and manage all operations. When discussing with me Adelina's exit from the program, Carlos said, "I hadn't even reached the point of letting Adelina know that she needed to start purchasing her own materials each month when she came to me and told me she had reached the moment financially where she wanted to buy her own materials out of the daycare's income!



She not only wants independence, but she is also passionate about providing solutions so that her neighbors can have it as well."

One mom whose children are attending the daycare was noted saying that she had gone through 15 different caretakers for her children; always arriving at difficulties in having a caretaker and a good environment for her children. She reported that her children being at Adelina's daycare **has changed everything for them**; not only are they excited to go every day but she is also at peace knowing that they are so well cared for.

The unavailability of childcare or daycares is one of the leading causes for families in poor communities being split apart. Parents are unable to go to work because of small children at home, or children are left at home alone which often results in them being sent to orphanages for care. Adelina has successfully created a solution that this very day is keeping families together! Her success today is YOUR SUCCESS! Why? Because as a partner of Identity Mission you have successfully chosen a way to support orphan care that actually results in changes that keep kids out of the system altogether; keeps them from experiencing the trauma of being ripped from their families; and assists in building up their families so that they are healthier. However, every once in a while, there are families who are so eager to care for kids, but they are unable to provide the attention that the kids need because both spouses have to maintain full-time jobs.
